PROGRAM NOTES

Rocky Top, the country-bluegrass hit song, was first introduced and recorded by the Osborne Brothers in 1967 and later by Lynn Anderson in 1970. It has been acclaimed as one of Tennessee's seven official state songs and is listed by one newspaper as the seventh favorite among the top 100 songs of the south.

NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR

The tempo marking, Moderately Fast, is listed with a metronome marking of $\text{♩} = 80\text{--}96$ and may be adjusted to the ability of your ensemble. Clean articulation is more important for young bands than speed at this, their early introduction to this musical style.
